

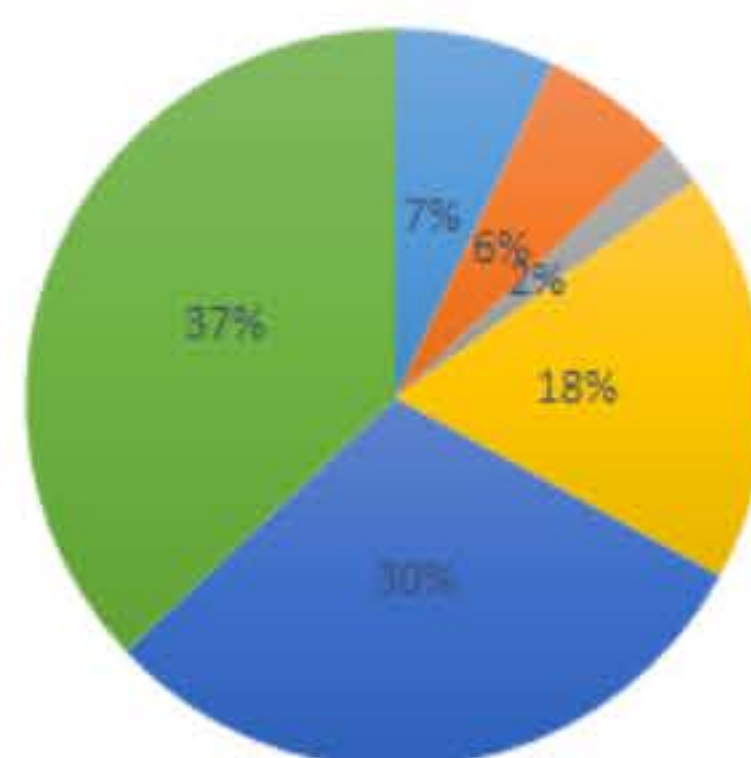

Environmental Health



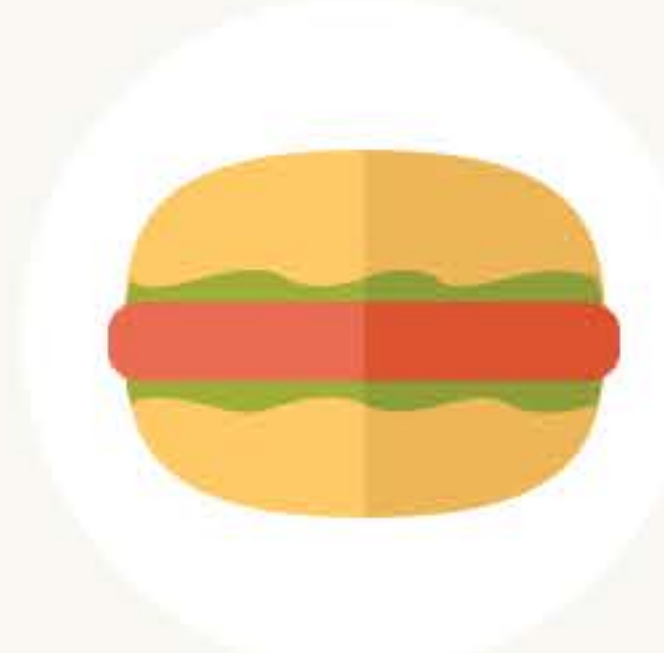
Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

- Disposed 145,576 pounds of waste
- 9 HHW collection events
- 2507 pounds of unused medication collected



Water Quality

- 982 well and septic inspections
- 272 pool inspections
- Collected and tested 882 water samples at local beaches



Food Service

- 4237 food service inspections
- 343 food complaints investigated
- 113 plan reviews completed

Health Promotion/Disease Control



Screenings & Referrals

- 39,194 hearing screenings
- 55,194 vision screenings
- 22,975 women, infants and children enrolled in WIC



Education

- 428 car seat inspections
- 48 WIC breastfeeding classes with 696 participants
- 89 healthy eating classes taught to 1452 participants



Disease Control

- 3816 cases of disease & 8 outbreaks investigated
- 1073 people tested for HIV at our free STD/HIV clinics
- 1445 directly observed therapy home visits for TB

Family Health Services



Maternal Child Health

- 280 Infant Safety Expo participants
- 1073 public health nursing home visits
- 466 children enrolled in health insurance



Clinic Services

- 3255 visits to the Family Planning Clinic
- 1435 clients served at the Dental Clinic
- 4987 people received health information, resources or referrals



Immunizations

- 9606 adults received vaccines
- 11,749 children received vaccines
- 8950 flu shots administered
